## WONDERBUG DISCOVERIES (AGES 18 MONTHS- 3 YEARS WITH PARENT) (ACY) JUNE 10-JULY 19, JULY 22-AUGUST 25

This parent-child nature discovery program is highly sensory-based involving themed storybooks, songs, hands-on time, and outdoor time with exploratory walks through the Purdy Nature Preserve. Each week will focus on a different theme or topic in nature. A portion of each class will be held outdoors, weather permitting, so dress accordingly! Class will not be held on July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

# OUTRAGEOUS OUTDOORS (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY) JUNE 10-JULY 19, JULY 22-AUGUST 25

This exciting class gives your child a chance to learn all about the beauty and wonder of the natural world through hands-on activities, games, stories and crafts related to the nature theme of the week, as well as time outdoors exploring nature. Please have your child dressed for the weather as a portion of each class will be held outdoors, weather permitting. Class will not be held on July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## POND ADVENTURES (AGES 5-9 YEARS) (ACY) JUNE 10-JULY 19

Learn about frogs, tadpoles, turtles, aquatic insects and more in this hands-on class. Dress to get your feet wet and muddy! Class includes outdoor activities as well as crafts, games, and stories. No class July 4<sup>th</sup>.

# LET'S TAKE A HIKE (AGES 5-9 YEARS) (ACY) JULY 22-AUGUST 25

Join us for short hikes on the Purdy preserve while we learn each week about different animals that call the preserve their home, including deer, chipmunks, and songbirds. There will be time to explore both on and off the trail and for games and other activities as well!

## ARCHERY 101 (AGES 8-14) (ACY) JUNE 10-AUGUST 25

Learn the basics of archery including the "11 steps to becoming a successful archer." Class follows National Archery in Schools Program (NASP) guidelines. All equipment is provided, but experienced students may bring their own equipment if it meets the instructor's standards. Class will be held outdoors. No class July 1<sup>st</sup>.
