FALL II SESSION: OCTOBER 25, 2021- DECEMBER 19, 2021

WONDERBUG DISCOVERIES (AGES 18 MONTHS- 3 YEARS WITH PARENT) (ACY)

This parent-child nature discovery program is highly sensory-based involving themed storybooks, songs, hands-on time, and outdoor time with exploratory walks through the Purdy Nature Preserve. Each week will focus on a different theme or topic in nature. A portion of each class will be held outdoors, weather permitting, so dress accordingly!

ANIMALS IN THE FALL- SEP 7-OCT 24 (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY)

Discover how animals get ready for winter through hibernation, migration, and food collection. We will learn about black bears, ducks and geese, squirrels and more through stories, games, and simple crafts. Class will go outside when the weather allows, so please have children dressed for the weather. Class held on Mondays between Sep 7 and Oct 24.

CREEPY CRITTERS- OCT 25-DEC 19 (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY)

We will learn about nocturnal creatures such as raccoons, skunks, owls, bats, spiders and more through stories, games, and hands-on learning. Find out why it can be exciting instead of creepy to hear strange sounds outdoors at nighttime. Class will go outside when weather allows, so please have children dressed for the weather. Class held on Mondays between Oct 25 and Dec 19.

OUTRAGEOUS OUTDOORS (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY)

This exciting class gives your child a chance to learn all about the beauty and wonder of the natural world through hands-on activities, games, stories and crafts related to the nature theme of the week, as well as time outdoors exploring nature. Have your child dressed for the weather as a portion of this class will be held outdoors, weather permitting.

ARCHERY 101- SEP 7-OCT 24 (AGES 8-14) (ACY)

Learn the basics of archery in this class including the '11 steps to becoming a successful archer'. Class follows the National Archery in Schools Program (NASP) guidelines. All equipment is provided. Class will be held outdoors and is only available during session 1.
