Lunch & Learn: Fox River Locks: Christine Williams of the Appleton Historical Society will give a presentation on the history of the Fox River locks system. Learn how the hand-operated lock works, the lives of the lockmaster who lived with their family in government owned houses adjacent to the locks, and the fight to preserve the system which led to the transfer of the locks from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to the State of Wisconsin in 2005.
