## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

### Get Connected Stay Connected, Technology Programs

In December 2019, we were awarded a \$50,000 grant from Bader Philanthropies to address social isolation through the use of technology. This grant funding would allow us to create a new program where we could help our community learn more about their technology and how to take full advantage of their devices. Unfortunately, just as we were preparing to begin this new programming through our **Get Connected Stay Connected** program, the country shut down. As you know, we all were immediately thrown into a world where we were required to use our technology to stay connected.

When the Y was able to open programming again and started offering Get Connected Stay Connected, we quickly learned how much this programming was needed. In 2021, we had 16 participants attend our small group classes and 88 attend a one-on-one appointment. In 2022, the growth continued, and we had 166 participants attend our small group classes and 209 attend a one-on-one appointment.

At the end of 2022, when the grant funding was exhausted, the Y committed to continue offering our community this technical support. As a result, the Get Connected Stay Connected programming expanded in 2023 from one location, the Neenah-Menasha YMCA, to three facilities including Fox West YMCA and

Ogden YMCA. This year, with the introduction of the new Tech Lab, powered by Plexus, at the Neenah-Menasha YMCA, we will be expanding again!

We are excited about this growth and hope you will consider taking advantage of this no-cost or low-cost technical support/training. Please consider joining us at one of our upcoming programs.

Walking our indoor track and attending deep water exercise classes is where her engagement first began. Lori went on to attend a variety of fitness classes offered at the YMCA including Zumba, Yoga, and Cycling, meeting many friends along the way. Great friends and community became important to her after being diagnosed with Stage 3 colon cancer in 1999. Her continued commitment to staying physically active is what she credits as having played a big role in overcoming cancer. Lasting friendships formed at the Neenah-Menasha YMCA have also helped see her through her husband's death in 2019.

At 91, you can still find Lori upstairs, every day at 6:00 AM using our weight machines as she follows up with a swim, similar to where she began here 26 years ago. She enjoys connecting over coffee Monday mornings in the Neenah-Menasha YMCA café with another group of strong individuals who have also overcome cancer. Lori is also passionate about spending time with her five children, many grand-children and many more great grand-children.
