Both of my children got their start with volleyball at the YMCA, and I'll always be grateful for the role this organization

"My journey with the YMCA started when things were tough. I was dealing with being bigger and facing bullies at school. It was rough. But then, during a checkup with my doctor, she suggested the YMCA. She said they had cool stuff and personal trainers that could help me out. So, my family and I decided to give it a shot.

When I first walked into the YMCA, I was nervous. I didn't really know how to work out or anything like that. But then, I met Becky, my personal trainer. She was super cool and took things slow with me. That made a big difference. With her help, I started feeling more comfortable and confident.

Working with Becky, I've seen some awesome changes. Stuff that I thought I couldn't do, like push-ups, I'm totally doing now! It's crazy to see how much progress I've made. And it's not just about getting stronger physically; I feel stronger on the inside too.

Going to the YMCA isn't just about exercising. It's about feeling motivated and believing in myself. The YMCA has become a place where I can push myself and achieve things I never thought I could. I'm thankful for the YMCA for helping me find my strength and confidence. It's made a big difference in my





"My journey with the YMCA stretches back to 1997. Back then, I mostly stuck to walking the track and taking deep water swims for a good ten years, and my husband often joined me. But life takes its turns, and he passed away in 2019. Still, I continued, finding solace and purpose in my daily visits.

My daughter Mickey joined the Y in 2017 when she participated in the LIVE**STRONG** program. Mickey recalls, "I remember hearing about the LIVE**STRONG** program after my own battle with cancer in '09. Work kept me busy, but once I retired, I made it a point to return to the Y. I even convinced my husband to join me, and later on, I encouraged my mother-in-law and sister-in-law to join, too. From then on, it became a regular part of our lives."

These days, Lory's routine involves a bit of time upstairs, using the machines for about 45 minutes, followed by an hour in the pool. "We're not exactly swimming champions, but we're moving, and that's what counts. It's comfortable, and it's the friendships that keep me coming back.

Over the years, I've seen friendships blossom within these walls. Some faces change, but others, like my friend Alice, remain constant, it's the camaraderie that makes each visit special."

Recently, Mickey had major back surgery that slowed her down for a bit. "I was able to use YMCA360 to keep up with my stretches at home, easing myself back into my routine when I returned. It's kept me mobile, and I'm grateful for the support of my Y community."

"There's something about the Y that gets me up in the morning, eager to start my day. It's become a vital part of my life, and I feel fortunate to be here, surrounded by friends and supported on my journey to wellness," said Lory.






