In 2024, the YMCA of the Fox Cities provided **\$4.6 million** in direct community benefits funding essential programs like childcare, health initiatives, and financial assistance. Community support totaled \$2.5 million, resulting in \$2.1 million unmet funding need, which highlights the importance of additional local support.

For every \$1.00 received, the Y provides \$1.84 of community benefit, ensuring that everyone has access to the Y's life-changing programs. Collectively, with our partners and key stakeholders the Y remains committed to strengthening community.

Including 30% youth under age 19, we enhance the Y experience by embedding our core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility into every interaction.


