WINTER 1 PROGRAM SESSION:

January 5 – February 22, 2026

WONDERBUG DISCOVERIES (AGES 18 MONTHS- 3 YEARS WITH PARENT) (ACY)

This parent-child nature discovery program is highly sensory-based involving themed storybooks, songs, hands-on time, and outdoor time with exploratory walks through the Purdy Nature Preserve. Each week will focus on a different theme or topic in nature. A portion of each class will be held outdoors, weather permitting, so dress accordingly!

ECO-KIDS (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY)

Explore the outdoors and watch the changes throughout the seasons while we learn more about nature and ourselves. This class helps children tie the Y's core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility to themselves, nature, and their community. Short hikes and playtime outside will be supplemented with craft and story time indoors. Have your child dressed for the weather as we will be outdoors every week, weather permitting!

OUTRAGEOUS OUTDOORS (AGES 3-5 YEARS) (ACY)

This exciting class gives your child a chance to learn all about the beauty and wonder of the natural world through hands-on activities, games, stories and crafts related to the nature theme of the week, as well as time outdoors exploring nature. Have your child dressed for the weather as much of this class will be held outdoors, weather permitting.

FIELD STUDIES AND PHENOLOGY (AGES 3-16 YEARS) (ACY)

Based off the Wild Wonder Foundation, this nature journaling class for all ages places its focus on different over-arching themes to consider the core writing prompts of "I Notice, I Wonder, and It Reminds Me Of." Each class will consist of an introduction to the theme, outdoor exploration time, and journaling. Registration includes a nature journal and supplies for journaling are provided. Families are encouraged to sign up together, and parents are encouraged to join the class and participate in the activities.

JUST PLAY OUTSIDE (AGES 5-10 YEARS) (ACY)

This is an opportunity for your child to come to the Y and go outside and play. Students will arrive after school to play games, explore the preserve, play in the snow or on the playground, and just have fun!

OUTDOOR EXPLORERS CLUB (AGES 5-10 YEARS) (ACY)

Let the Environmental Education team at the Apple Creek YMCA turn your off-day from school into a full day of exploration and activities related to the outdoors. Join us for hikes, playing in the woods, creative free time, and more! Pack a nut-free lunch, snacks and appropriate clothing for indoors and outdoors in a backpack and join us for a fun-filled day! LIVE ANIMAL CARE (AGES 6-12 YEARS) (ACY)

Drop your child off on the second Saturday of each month in the Nature Study Classroom to learn how we care for our classroom animals, including snakes, lizards, turtles, frogs, and fish. Help feed the animals, clean their tanks, and make sure they are living healthy lives. We will occasionally bring our lessons outdoors, so please dress accordingly.
